2. Roles and Responsibilities of Anti Ragging Committees

1. Receive and Acknowledge Complaints

- Accept grievances from students, faculty, or staff in written, digital, or verbal form.
- Acknowledge receipt of complaints within 3 working days.

2. Register and Track Grievances

- Maintain a Grievance Register (manual or digital) to record.

3. Create Awareness

- Educate students and staff about grievance redressal mechanisms.
- Promote visibility of the GRC email, contact, and process via:
 - Notice boards
 - College website
 - Orientation programs

3. Action Procedure

1. Submission & Acknowledgment:

- Grievance is submitted via written application, email, or online portal.
- The committee acknowledges receipt within 3 working days and registers the complaint.

2. Inquiry & Resolution:

- GRC conducts a fair inquiry by hearing the parties involved and reviewing evidence.
- A resolution is provided within 15–30 working days, and action is taken as needed.

3. Closure & Escalation:

- The case is documented and marked as resolved.
- If not satisfied, the complainant may appeal to the University Ombudsperson or AICTE Portal.
